

Plumbing Plan Review Agreements

Municipalities which have established a formal agreement with the State of Minnesota to do plumbing plan review are listed below. These cities and cities of the First Class, such as; Minneapolis, Saint Paul and Duluth are the only cities authorized to perform plumbing plan review in lieu of a review by the Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). These agreements are subject to review, and can be altered if deemed necessary to assure compliance with the Plumbing Code. Plumbing plans may be submitted directly to those cities for review, except for the following:

- Hospitals, nursing homes, supervised living facilities, and similar health care related facilities regulated by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) must be submitted to both DLI and MDH Engineering Services. The MDH Web site is located at: www.health.state.mn.us/divs/fpc/engineering.html.
- Buildings owned by the Federal or State government must be submitted to DLI.
- Projects of special nature for which DLI review is requested by either the city or the state should be submitted to DLI.
