## **V. Regular Business**

### **A. High Pressure Piping Code**

- i. Wendy Legge briefed the sub-committee and explained the changes that were made by the Legislature eliminating the classification of trainee and establishing the title of unlicensed individual. She stated that a notice of intent to adopt changes to the High Pressure Piping rules concerning the change from trainee to unlicensed individual should be published by December 31, 2008 or the power to make these changes might be lost.

Discussed the requirement for the annual registration of unlicensed individuals, in addition the requirement for direct supervision of unlicensed individuals and apprentices were also discussed. Wendy Legge will supply the group with the definitions currently in place for direct supervision found in the Electrical and Plumbing Codes in order to determine if these definitions possibly will work in the High Pressure Piping rules.

The definition of "Direct Supervision" will be part of the agenda for the next meeting.

Requirements for out of state fabricators: Todd Green stated that the requirements of out of state fabricators concerning licensing was the same as for in-state fabricators.

Wendy Legge will prepare a draft of possible changes. Section 5230.0115 was reviewed with the possibility of dropping parts b, c, and d of sub part 1 and sub parts 3, 4, and 5 in their entirety. The wording in sub-parts 2 and 6 of section 5230.0115 must be reworded to match the statutes covering them.

## **VI. Adjournment**

A motion was made by Larry Stevens, seconded by Bastianelli to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor and the motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
