

## **General steps to obtain the most current rule language for the 2012 Codes**

Once the rules become effective, the proposed rules will be available on the Office of the Revisor's web site, but not before.

By using the three documents listed in the steps below, you will have the entire proposed rule, in pieces. Please note that the proposed rule changes may change certain provisions in the current (existing) rule. The change will supersede (override) the existing rule. Changes listed in the notice of adoption in the State Register will supersede the proposed changes contained in the proposed rule draft.

To obtain the most current rule for any rule chapter:

1. Obtain the current (existing) version for the rule chapter from the Revisor of Statutes web site: [www.revisor.mn.gov/rules/](http://www.revisor.mn.gov/rules/)
2. Obtain the proposed rule changes to the rule chapter that apply to the code or standard (e.g. IRC, IBC, etc.) by visiting the CCLD rulemaking web page and clicking on the appropriate rulemaking docket ([www.dli.mn.gov/RulemakingCCL.asp](http://www.dli.mn.gov/RulemakingCCL.asp)). Open the link for that docket and scroll down to "Availability of rule draft and SONAR" and click on the copy of the proposed rule draft. That will provide the changes that were proposed to the current (existing) rule.
3. Obtain the notice of adoption for that rulemaking to obtain any changes that were made to the proposed rules following the public comment period or hearing, if any changes were made. A link to this notice can be found in the last box of the rulemaking docket, which brings you to the State Register where the applicable notice was published.

**Note:** The CCLD is producing Minnesota ICC versions of the 2012 ICC codes that will be available beginning approximately fall 2014.
