1.5 Subp. 1a. **Electrical code.** All new electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment for
1.6 electric light, heat, power, technology circuits and systems, and alarm and communication
1.7 systems must comply with the regulations contained in the ~~2017~~ 2020 edition of the National
1.8 Electrical Code (NEC) as approved by the American National Standards Institute
1.9 (ANSI/NFPA ~~70-2017~~ 70-2020), Minnesota Statutes, section 326B.35, and the Minnesota
1.10 State Building Code as adopted by the commissioner of labor and industry. The ~~2017~~ 2020
1.11 edition of the National Electrical Code, developed and published by the National Fire
1.12 Protection Association, Inc., is incorporated by reference and made part of the Minnesota
1.13 State Building Code. The National Electrical Code is not subject to frequent change and is
1.14 available in the office of the commissioner of labor and industry, from the Minnesota
1.15 Bookstore, 660 Olive Street, Saint Paul, MN 55155, through public libraries, from major
1.16 bookstores and other retail sources, or from National Fire Protection Association, Inc., One
1.17 Batterymarch Park, Quincy, MA 02169-7471.

1.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** Minnesota Rules, part 1315.0200, is effective July 1, 2020, or five
1.20 business days after publication of the notice of adoption in the State Register, whichever is
1.21 later.
