The request is to adopt the UPC 2018 Section 712.1. The thrust of the requested changes are two-fold; allow air testing on PVC, and remove the water column test. The current Section 712.1 is the following:

Section 712.1 Media. The piping of the plumbing, drainage, and venting systems shall be tested with water or air except that plastic pipe shall not be tested with air. The Authority Having Jurisdiction shall be permitted to require the removal of cleanouts, etc., to ascertain whether the pressure has reached all parts of the system. After the plumbing fixtures have been set and their traps filled with water, they shall be submitted to a final test.

Since your form does not allow strikethroughs and underlines as required above, I propose that the wording be changed to read as follows:

Section 712.1 Media. The piping of the plumbing, drainage, and venting systems shall be tested with water or air. The Authority Having Jurisdiction shall be permitted toRega require the removal of cleanouts, etc., to ascertain whether the pressure has reached all parts of the system. Need and Reasons For the Change. Thoroughly explain the need and why you believe it is reasonable to make this change. During a rulemaking process, the need and reasonableness of all proposed rule changes must be justified; therefore, a detailed explanation is necessary to ensure the Board thoroughly considers all aspects of the proposal. Regarding the request to test PVC with air, this is currently allowed and we request that this remains. Regarding the request to remove the water column testing, there are a few aspects to this. This requirement causes undue hardship on the plumbing contractors because of the cost of man hours it takes to make this happen. Not all approved fixtures are tested to this standard, very likely because Minnesota is the only state in the union that requires this level of testing. It is very difficult to maintain the water column, so much so that it would be difficult to find a plumber in this state that doesn't know how to cheat the test. Any standard that causes dishonest practices to meet much of the time is not a laudable standard and should, therefore, be removed. It is well proven in many other states that the current practices of testing underground and rough-in piping are more than sufficient to install systems that protect the public as well as our environment.
