Worksheet and Code Change Proposal Review:

TAG Members reviewed the code change proposals below during April 16th, 2024 meeting.

Minnesota Rules, part 1302.0400, Definitions. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to update language by adding “places of public accommodations” to coordinate with MS 326B.108. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1302.0500, Responsibilities of State Building Official. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to add places of public accommodations. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1302.0700, Subp. 2. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify language to allow for electronic plan review, clarification of certification requirements, and updating referencing to other rules and statutes. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1302.0700, Subp. 3. State Building Official’s Duties. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify the language to allow the designer 30 days to respond to corrections instead of 14 days and to allow the Department to charge additional plan review fees when the response is submitted after 30 days. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1302.0850, Code administration by commissioner. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify language adding places of public accommodation. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1303.1200. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to repeal rule requirements for restroom facilities in public accommodations. Chapter 29 of the MN Building Code requires higher ratios of toileting facilities for both women and men than the 3:2 ratio in rule. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1303.1300, Space for commuter van. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to repeal rule language requiring space for commuter vans. Sustainable transportation has changed and no longer supports regular use of commuter van spaces. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1303.1500, Recycling space. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify rule language for “recycling space” by removing minimum space requirement and adding language to require a separate recycling chute when a solid waste chute is provided. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.

Minnesota Rules, part 1303.1600, Subp. 2. Soil under slab on grade. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify rule language and add language to require a drainage system to prevent water accumulation within filled areas.

Minnesota Rules, part 1300.0070 Definitions, Single-family dwelling. TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to add a definition for single-family dwelling. TAG members tabled the proposal to revise the language and allow other TAG members to provide research or additional language for clarification.

Minnesota Rules, part 1300.0070 Definitions, Two-family dwelling. TAG members tabled the proposal to revise language and allow other TAG members to provide research or additional language for clarification.
