1: What is Work Comp Campus?

Work Comp Campus, the Department of Labor and Industry's (DLI's) new workers' compensation claims portal, rolled out Nov. 2. The move from a paper-based, form-driven system to an online and data-driven system allows Campus to be accessible and available on computers, tablets and smartphones, meeting the expectations of today's Minnesotans, who want quick, easy access to their workers' compensation claim information.

2: How does Campus benefit health care providers?

- Work Comp Campus allows health care providers to have access to an easy online system for filing medical reports and having a consolidated view of claims and disputes to which they are a party.
- The ability to easily receive and file medical requests for more efficient resolution from DLI.
- Accurately report information so insurers can reimburse injured employees for medical expenses.
