1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Chair McLellan. Housekeeping announcements were made.

2. Introductions

Members and guests introduced themselves and a quorum was declared with 13 of 18 members present or via teleconference.

3. Approval of meeting agenda

A motion was made by Paradise, seconded by Erdman, to approve the agenda as presented. The roll call vote was unanimous with 13 votes in favor; the motion carried.

McLellan referred to the "Draft Timeline for Adoption of 2018 Model Codes" dated 11/28/2017 and discussed goal timelines.

Regarding the Residential Energy Code: The TAG will review to the extent possible, justification for adopting a new residential energy code.

Regarding the likeliness of adopting the Green Construction Code (IGCC): McLellan said there is no commitment to adopt a green code, primarily because the department does not have the specific statutory authority.
