Agenda key

Anticipated interactions to assist panel members with meeting preparation

Debate

Item on the agenda may be contentious and additional time may be required for panel members to express their ideas.

Decide

Panel members need to make a decision today.

Discuss

To present in detail for examination or consideration. Panel members may be asked for their recommendation.

Inform/clarify

An opportunity to receive the most recent information or to gain additional information about an item. May ask questions to increase panel's knowledge for future panel-related discussion and decision.

Create

Design item, project, program, etc. from scratch, which may take more than one meeting to accomplish.

Develop

Take an established idea or item and expand upon or improve it. This may take more than one meeting to accomplish.

Note: A quorum of at least seven members is required to conduct a meeting.
