**Proposed Amendment to Rules Governing Adoption of the National Electrical Code,
Minnesota Rules, Part 1315.0200**

To persons who requested a hearing. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 14.25, subdivision 1, the Department is sending this Notice to all persons who requested a hearing.

There will be a hearing. In the March 31, 2008, State Register, on pages 1808 to 1810, the Board of Electricity published a Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules relating to adoption of the National Electrical Code. The Notice stated that the Department would hold a hearing on the proposed rules if 25 or more persons submitted written requests. We have received a sufficient number of requests for a hearing. The hearing will be conducted as stated in the State Register in the Minnesota Room of the Department of Labor and Industry located at 443 Lafayette Road North in St. Paul, starting at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 13, 2008.
