Possible Rules Governing the Residential Energy Code, Minnesota Rules, part 1322.0403, R-04294					
Subject matter	The Department of Labor and Industry is proposing amendments to rules governing insulation of all outdoor air intakes, exhaust, supply, and return air ducts and plenums, and other residential energy code things that come up, as time permits. The Department is considering rule amendments that will change certain minimum insulation R-values. Some R-values currently in the Mechanical and Fuel Gas Code, Minnesota Rules, part 1346.0604, have been moved to the Minnesota Residential Energy Code, part 1322.0403, subpart 1. This rulemaking amends some of the recently moved R-values.
