A. High Pressure Piping Code

Repair, Todd Green and Wendy Legge discussed the Board's ability to regulate repair because no license is required. The idea was to define repair and if no license was required to have the repair still governed by the code.

Wendy Legge advised the committee that the board has no authority to make rules for unlicensed work and therefore a repair program is not possible.

Wendy Legge proposed language defining repair to be presented to the Board.

Green made a motion to bring the subject of repair to the full Board Steven seconded vote was unanimous.

Integral process, other medium and the definition of high pressure piping system was discuss Geisenhoff is to provide language.

Limited license was discussed and tabled until Wendy Legge has more time to research if the Board has the power to act on this subject. Limited license will not be part of this rule making cycle.
