


## MEDIATOR COMPOSITE RESUME

The mediation staff at the Department of Labor and Industry is composed of 15 mediators.

- Eight mediators are licensed attorneys with more than a century of combined experience in the practice of law, including Minnesota workers' compensation. Two mediators are former workers' compensation judges; one mediator served as a state District Court judge and as director of a national arbitration and mediation company. Several of the mediators have appellate experience before the Workers' Compensation Court of Appeals, the Minnesota Court of Appeals and/or the Minnesota Supreme Court.
- Five mediators have experience as workers' compensation claims administrators for insurers, self-insurers and third-party administrators. Five mediators have a combined 32 years experience as compliance analysts for the Department of Labor and Industry.
- One mediator has experience in vocational rehabilitation services, having served as the Department of Labor and Industry's vocational rehabilitation policy analyst for five years and having provided rehabilitation services for 20 years, including vocational testing, retraining and job-placement services.
- Three mediators have a combined 13 years of experience in the medical field.
- One bilingual mediator (Spanish/English) has intercultural experience in the Hispanic community.
- One mediator has served as supervisor of the department's Compliance Services team; director of the Special Compensation Fund; and acting assistant commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry.
