Adjustable-height worktables used in computer assembly

Height-adjustable worktables help maintain an ideal working height for easier assembly of computer mainframes. The in-floor design allows for computer mainframes to be rolled onto the table. The hydraulic-lift table can then be adjusted to the appropriate height for the task, minimizing awkward postures while working.



A flexible guard eliminates potential contact with pinch points.



A locking system, designed in-house, prevents rolling while work is performed. Operators can also rotate the tabletop when necessary.
