Worksheet and Code Change Proposal Review:

TAG Members reviewed the code change proposals described below.

Minnesota Rules, part 1300.0070 Definitions

The TAG members reviewed a code change proposal to modify the definition of "manufactured home" and add definitions for "mobile home," "industrialized/modular building," "prefabricated building," and "tiny house." The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal with the following modifications: deleting the reference to Group IRC-1 occupancies from the definition of manufactured home, changing the term "industrialized/modular building" to "industrialized/modular construction," and adding IRC-2 and R-3 occupancies to the definition of prefabricated buildings.

Minnesota Rules, part 1301.0300, Subpart 4, Prerequisite experience and education points

The TAG members reviewed a code change proposal that awards applicants for building official or building official limited 100 points for obtaining a BIT AAS degree or associate's degree, 60 points for obtaining a Construction codes and inspections certificate, and 28 points for obtaining a BIT certificate. The TAG consensus is to accept the code change proposal.
