Worksheet Review:

The TAG reviewed the worksheet at this meeting. Starting with chapter 7, line 20 and ending with chapter 8, line 26.

Chapter 7:

- Worksheet Line 26, 27, section R703.4, flashing. The TAG consensus is to modify the model code section to include items 9 and 10 in current Minnesota Rules, part 1309.0703, subpart 2b.
- Worksheet Line 28, section R703.4.1, pan flashing of windows and doors. The TAG consensus is to delete the current Minnesota amendment that modifies this section and accept the 2024 IRC model code language as written.
- Worksheet Line 34, section R703.7, exterior plaster (stucco). The TAG consensus is to delete the current Minnesota amendment that modifies this section and accept the 2024 IRC model code language as written.
- Worksheet Line 35, section R703.7.1, lath. The TAG consensus is to delete the current Minnesota amendment that modifies this section and accept the 2024 IRC model code language as written.

- Worksheet Line 37, section R703.7.1.1, control joints and expansion joints. The TAG consensus is to delete the current Minnesota amendment that modifies this section and accept the 2024 IRC model code language as written.
