<u>IEBC 202 Definitions – Technically Infeasible and MR 1311.202 Definitions for Technically Infeasible, Accessibility</u> and Technically Infeasible Stair Construction

The TAG reviewed all three definitions with the consensus to defer to the recommendations of the 1311 and 1341 TAGs for these terms.
