Unlicensed Maple Grove contractor fined \$11,000

 An unlicensed contractor operating out of Maple Grove was found to have engaged in residential remodeling, electrical and plumbing work without being licensed. The contractor was ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$11,000.



 A licensed Prior Lake residential building contractor was found to have breached contracts with homeowners by failing to complete projects after receiving payments. DLI revoked the contractor's license and assessed a \$37,500 fine, which was stayed contingent on full future compliance.

Enforcement actions

- An Illinois contractor was found to have engaged in unlicensed elevator work in the state of Minnesota.
 The contractor was ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$5,000, which was stayed contingent on full future compliance.
- A Ham Lake contractor was found to have performed plumbing work without a contractor license. The
 contractor was ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$2,500, which was
 stayed contingent on full future compliance.
- A Minneapolis contractor was found to have engaged in residential building construction, electrical and
 plumbing work without having the required licenses. The contractor was ordered to cease and desist
 from the unlicensed activities and fined \$7,000, of which \$5,000 was stayed contingent on full future
 compliance.
