M.R. CHAPTER 4714, SECTIONS 414.3, 704.3, AND 807.1

COMMERCIAL DISHWASHING MACHINES MUST DISCHARGE:

1) INDIRECTLY TO THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM THROUGH AN AIR BREAK, OR

2) DIRECTLY TO THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM WITH A FLOOR DRAIN CONSTRUCTED WITHOUT A BACKWATER VALVE INSTALLED ON THE HORIZONTAL DISHWASHER BRANCH AND LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE DISHWASHER.

THE WATER SUPPLY CONNECTION TO A COMMERCIAL DISHWASHING MACHINE MUST BE PROTECTED BY AN AIR GAP OR A BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 603.3.2, SECTION 603.3.5, SECTION 603.3.6, OR THAT COMPLIES WITH ASSE 1004 (SEE M.R. CHAPTER 4714, SECTION 414.2).
